

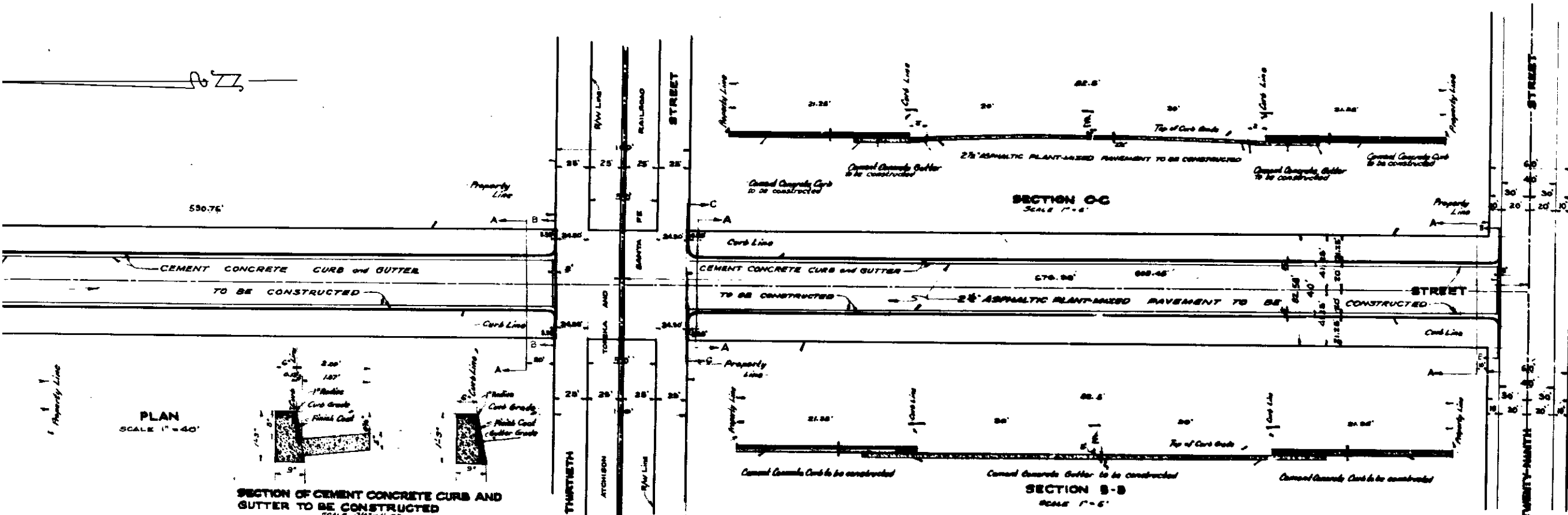

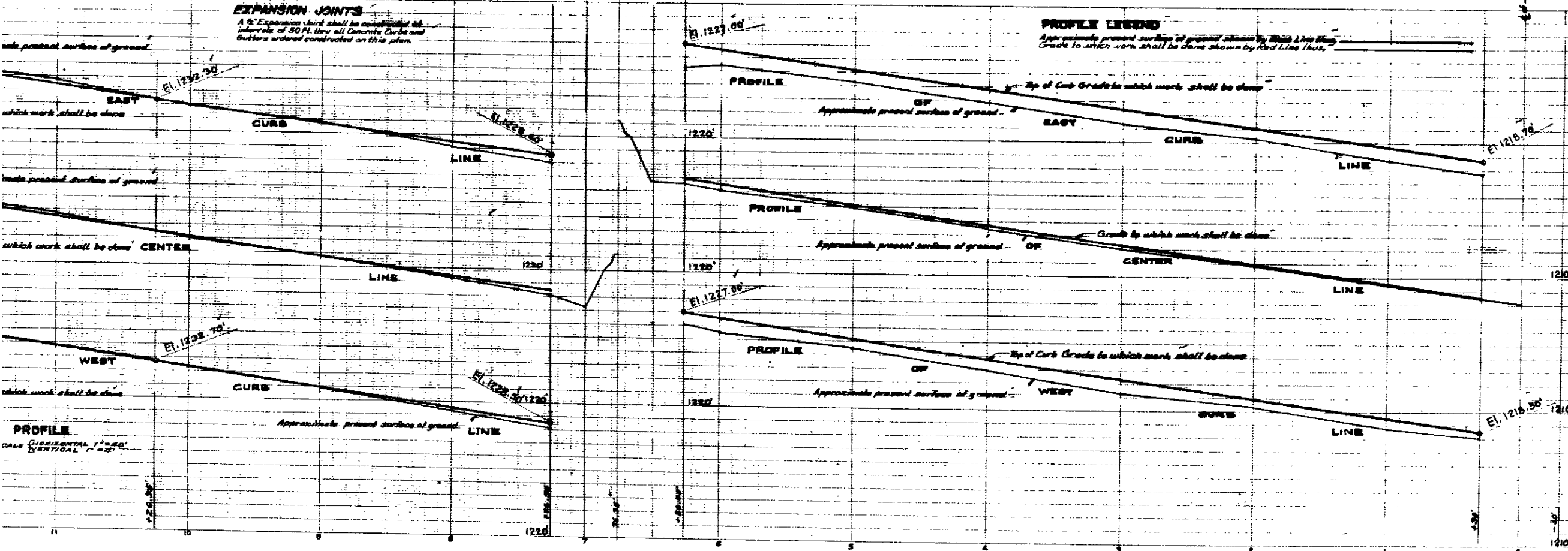

TITLE TO STREETS
LE ROY STREET was dedicated as Aliso Street by map of Arroyohead Tract, recorded in Book 11 of maps of page 27, records of San Bernardino County, California. Aliso Street was changed to LE ROY STREET by Resolution No 358 of the City of San Bernardino Adopted Feb. 8, 1936.

GRADE ORDINANCE
Grade of LE ROY STREET was established by Resolution No 1638 of the City of San Bernardino, California. Adopted Nov. 28, 1948. Width of Sidewalk and Curb Line established by Resolution No 1641 of the City of San Bernardino Adopted February 21, 1949.

DATUM
All Elevations shown in Red ink are in feet and are above a plane which is 1045.28 feet below the City Bench Mark as established by Ordinance 285 of the City of San Bernardino, California.
