



NOTE: - All Curb Returns shall be constructed on a 10' Radius.
EXPANSION JOINTS -
A 1/2" expansion joint shall be constructed thru all cement concrete ordered to be constructed on this plan at each side of driveways where concrete joins existing concrete, at returns and at intervals of 50 feet.

NOTE: - Residential Driveway shown as existing. Commercial Driveway to be constructed of 4" thick concrete. All driveways shall be constructed on ground plan and finished to existing grade. All locations where the driveway is to be constructed are shown to be constructed by the driveway that is constructed only from the curb to the existing sidewalk.
