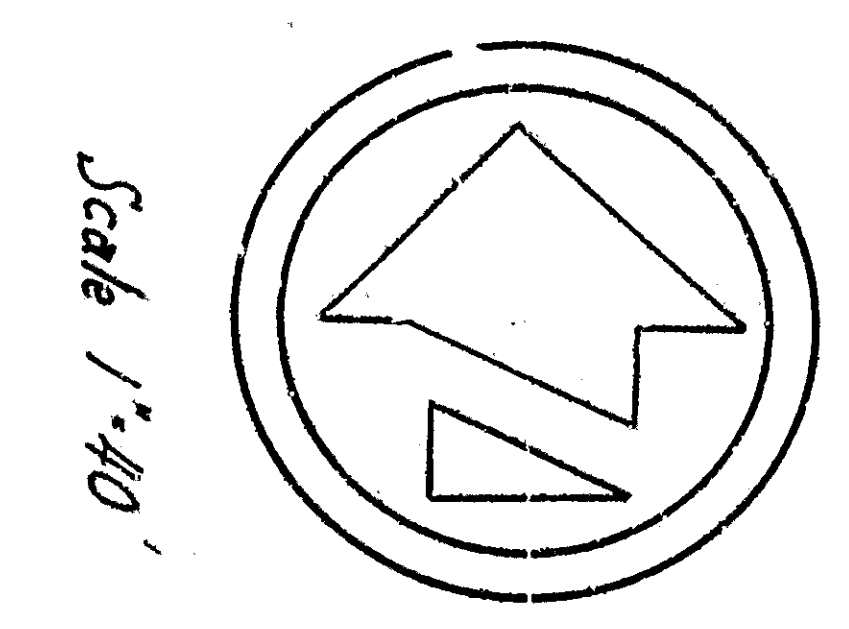
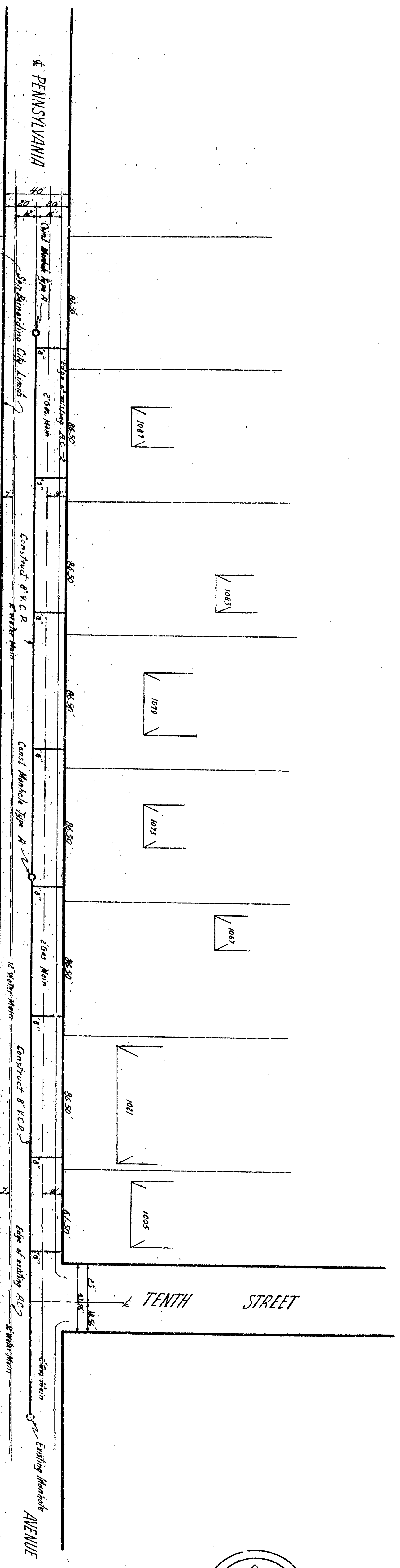


GENERAL NOTE

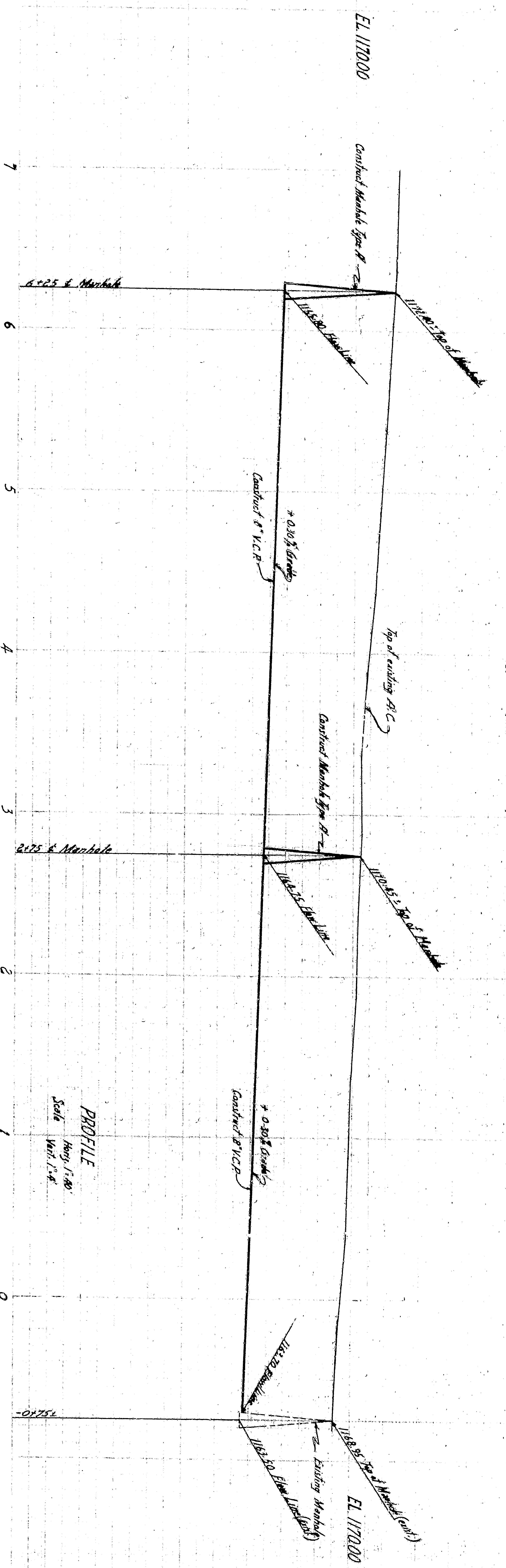
1. All work indicated on this plan shall be done in conformity with applicable provisions of Standard Specifications No. 2271 and Standard Drawings No. 551 on file in the Office of the City Engineer.
2. All new construction projects shall be constructed on an upward grade of the present from the main street and shall extend from the main street to the proposed line.
3. 8 1/4" pipes with 8" bitumastic coating shall be constructed on these lines.
4. All new connections and appurtenances and level changes shall be designed in the field.
5. Locations of manholes shall be on and to the right and to be exact on complete and the City assumes no responsibility for errors or omissions in showing such locations.
6. Contractors shall verify the location of all underground utilities and be most accurate in locating them for purposes connected with this operation.
7. Manholes to be constructed shall be of cast iron or vitrified clay pipe.
8. Sewer mains shall be constructed of vitrified clay pipe.
9. Speed limit of 15 miles per hour shall be maintained.
10. Roadway shall be constructed of 1/2" bitumastic coating.
11. Roadway shall be constructed of 1/2" bitumastic coating.

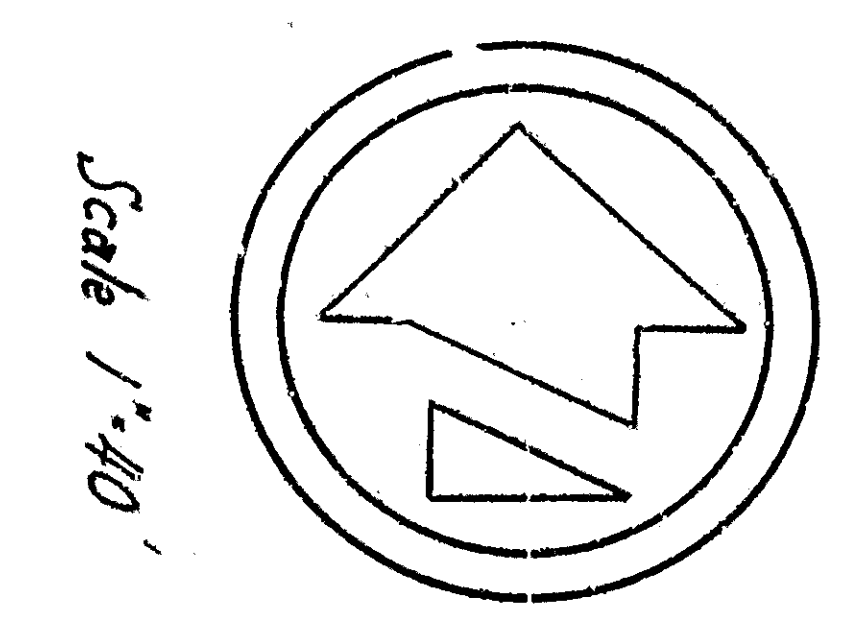
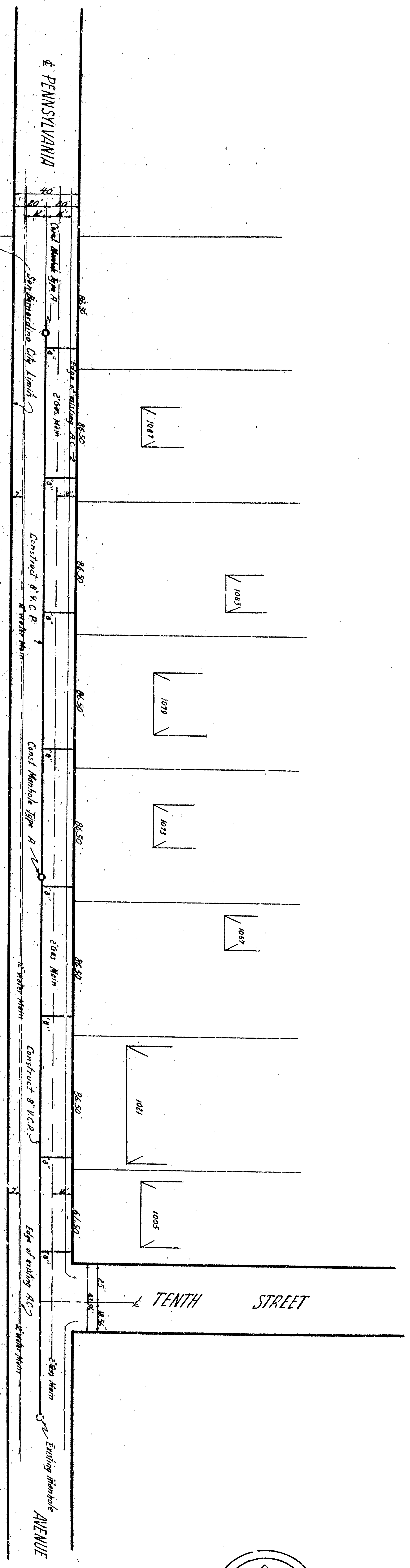

GENERAL NOTES

1. All work indicated on this plan shall be done in conformity with applicable provisions of Standard Specifications No. 2271 and Standard Drawings No. 551, on file in the Office of the City Engineer.
2. All new construction projects shall be constructed on an upward grade of five percent from the main street and shall extend from the main street to the property line.
3. 8" x 8" pipes with 8" high steel collars for connecting street to be constructed are shown.
4. All new connections and appurtenances and level changes shall be designed in the field.
5. Locations of underground utilities are not to be assumed & be exact as complete and the City assumes no responsibility for errors or omissions in showing such locations.
6. Contractors shall verify or determine the location of all underground utilities and be most accurate all liabilities for damages caused by this operation.
7. Manholes to be constructed to 4' diameter and all street manholes shall be 4' diameter.
8. Street manholes shall be constructed to 4' diameter and all street manholes shall be 4' diameter.
9. Street manholes shall be constructed of brick or concrete.
