Lampholes shall be constructed of eight (8) inch vitrified sewer ripe of the quality and pattern shown in this specification under "Sewer Pipe" and shall be connected to the main sewer by an eight by eight (8 x 8) inch vitrified T Branch, said sewer pipe shall be constructed in a vertical position to a point mine (9) inches below the top of the lamphole and shall be enclosed in consrets of the thickness shown on the plane. Lampholes shall be expect with coast iron frames and covers of the pettern and dimensions shown on the plane and get in concrete as shown on the plane. The castings shall be sound, free from cracks and flaws and thoroughly cleaned.

The contractor shall not allow any drains to be connected with the sever before emplotion and acceptance of the same,




